It has a steep head profile with the coloration varies from silvery to almost black with occasional dark spots, and the male may be turning black once it mature. The largest Giant Trevally reaches 1.7 meters in length and weighs over 60 kilograms.

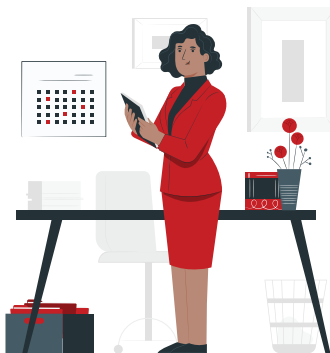

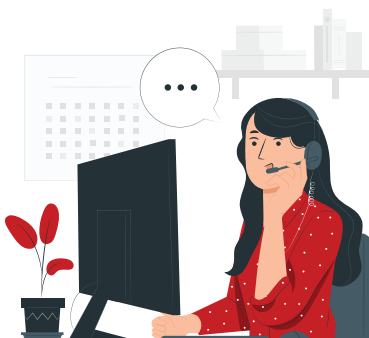
